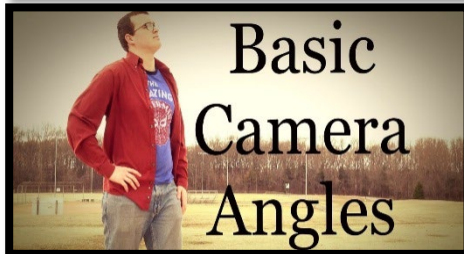
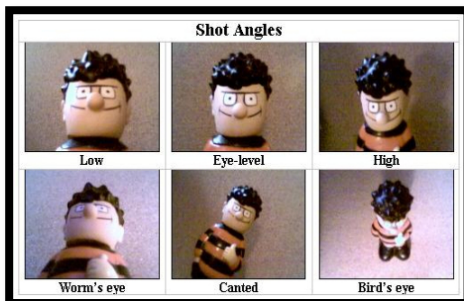


Film Technology & Audio-Video 1

Film Technology & Audio-Video 1 is a high school level course being offered to 7th grade students. This class is designed for students to understand, communicate, and deliver messages through film and audio. Students will be exposure to foundational knowledge in film hardware, editing software and music production, all taught in a computer lab with hands-on activities and project-focused tasks. Employability skills are integrated into activities, tasks, and projects throughout the course to demonstrate the skills required by business and industry.

Year-long in length, this class is the introductory course for the Film and Technology diploma pathway offered at Centennial. After completing this course, students may take the 2nd level audio-video film course at Centennial High School. This course will focus on the weekly segment aired each Friday.

Course requirements:

- Individuals considering this course should be self-motivated and dedicated to improving their understanding of storytelling, editing and visual arts.
- Individuals enrolled in Film Technology & Audio-Video 1 should understand that this course is for high school credit. Assignments, projects and assessments will be of equal rigor to the high school Film Technology & Audio-Video 1 curriculum.
- Students will be expected to complete the full year once they are enrolled in the Film Technology & Audio-Video 1 class (with the exception of extenuating circumstances, no student will be able to drop the class once enrolled).
- Students will have the option to opt-out of the high school credit once the final grade is earned.

Please submit a completed Audio-Video & Film Technology 1 application to Mr. McCown. The class is limited to 21 openings. All applications will be reviewed, and students will be notified if they were accepted into the course.
